# BRITISH COLUMBIA GUILD OF ENGLISH HANDBELL RINGERS' ANNUAL YOUTH FESTIVAL

**How the day works** *Ring Out!* 2020 is geared towards students who are in grades four to twelve, who would like to improve their handbell ringing. Over the past three years we have had a large number of beginner ringers join in the fun. There will be handchimes and handbells available for beginners to learn ringing techniques. Come have fun meeting other ringers from around the lower mainland. The cost for registration is \$15 for students and \$10 for chaperones. You can mail in your registration by Friday February 7, or register online at <a href="www.bcgehr.com">www.bcgehr.com</a>.

Students are split into small levelled clinics twice, where they work with one of the clinicians on music of their level. All ringers come together twice during the day, for massed ringing rehearsals, where students will work on two pieces, one with each clinician.

Morning snacks and refreshments will be provided by BCGEHR, but please remember to **bring your own lunch**. There will be games played during our lunch break, and you have a chance to win prizes.

A concert will be offered for family, friends and the community at 2:30 p.m. It is usually about twenty minutes long. Donations will be accepted at the door for our **Student Bursary Fund**, which is used to help students attend provincial events (Spring Ring), or national Handbell Musicians of Canada events (Ringing Link). We hope you can join us!
